Best Hospital Bed Sleep Surface Options

Hospital support surfaces differ from standard mattresses in several ways. First, a hospital bed mattress must adapt to a raised head and raised leg position. Hospital beds are adjustable at the head and foot area, offering raised postures depending upon the needs of the user. Many hospital beds also raise and lower the bed platform height to reduce the risk of falls to the patient and provide easier access by

caregivers. The adjustability of these beds makes additional demands upon mattresses for flexibility and firmness to meet patient requirements. Another consideration, particularly for long-term care patients, is pressure redistribution of the mattress to prevent pressure ulcers. Patients who spend considerable time in their bed tend to develop pressure sores upon their bodies at points where load-bearing is the greatest. These high-pressure points include the heel, hip, shoulders, and head. Mattress construction can compensate for pressure points by redistributing weight over a more significant surface area. Spreading the weight burden over a larger surface area reduces the risk of developing pressure ulcers.

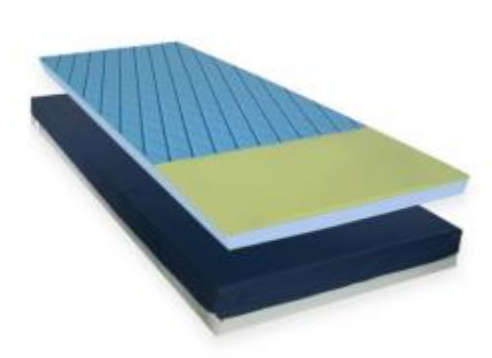

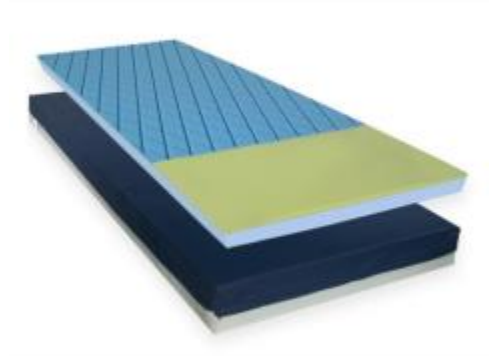
